THE INTELLIGENT BUNKER MANAGEMENT SYSTEM – The system of choice for bunkering companies

The Intelligent Bunker Management System (iBMS) is an integrated end-to-end solution offered by BTS Pte Ltd, and developed under the Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore (MPA)'s MINT fund. It was officially launched at the M Hotel on 4 Jul 06.

Targeted at bunker suppliers and traders, iBMS helps them to increase efficiency and profitability by optimizing their business processes. The user can expect better inter-department communication, automated workflow and access to information.

Capt M Segar, Director of Port/ Port Master, MPA, said: "To encourage maritime technology development, MPA has set up the S\$100 million Maritime Innovation and Technology (MINT) fund in 2003. One of the fruits of these MINT fund projects is the iBMS developed by BTS. I am glad to note that so far, 7 bunker suppliers have already adopted iBMS and are reaping the benefits of the new system."

The bunkering business is hugely complex and requires a high level of interaction among many parties in the supply chain. Spot deals can go through from enquiry to order and scheduling to delivery processes in as little as 24 hours. In this connection, it is important that there is a seamless flow of information.

The iBMS is a single integrated platform that centralizes all business activities from sales enquiry to quote, confirmation, scheduling, contract management, inventory management, delivery, invoicing and management reporting.

"With iBMS, bunker suppliers and traders can now make use of this platform to optimise their processes and achieve greater efficiency in their operations. Singapore is the top bunkering port in the world, and being able to develop iBMS locally in partnership with companies such as Gas Trade (S) Pte Ltd and Golden Island Diesel Oil Trading Pte Ltd, and having it accepted by the industry, is strong testament to the value proposition of iBMS." said Mr D S Reddy, CEO, BTS Pte Ltd.

He added: "MPA's MINT Fund had played an important role in helping BTS jumpstart our R&D projects in Singapore and we look forward to partnering MPA in their effort to develop the industry further."

Bunkering remains an important sector of the Singapore maritime industry. It generates revenue of up to S\$13.6 billion annually. Last year, a record of more than 25 million tonnes of bunker was sold in Singapore.
